## Railton Topiary Trail

Railton residents have spent the past decade building topiary in their streets and front yards. From Ned Kelly to a spider, the last "living" Tasmanian tiger to a life-size steam train. And check out the famous mother and baby elephant. Drop in to any Railton business for a topiary map.



## Henry Somerset Orchid Reserve

Located on Railton Rd, just north of Railton this Reserve is nationally renowned for its diversity of native terrestrial orchids. Many are rare and endangered, and some are not only endemic to Tasmania, but 14 are endemic to the local area. The walk takes approximately 30-45 minutes.



## Sykes Sanctuary

Eccentric recluse Norman Sykes lived in forest near Railton to get away from people and because he felt nature was good for the soul. In 1977, he left his land to the people and was never seen again.
