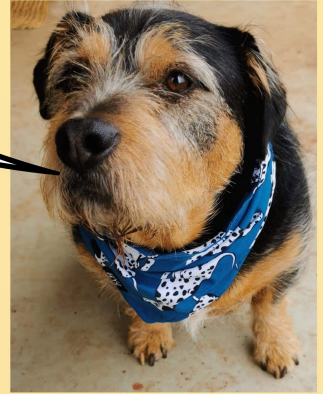
DOG CONTROL ACT 2000 (TAS)

Dogs are registered for the period 1st July 2023 to 30th June 2024

Council offers a \$5 discount on the full fee if registration is paid on or before 31/07/2023

Kennel Licence - Multiple Dogs

A kennel licence is required if you have on your premises:

- (a) more than 2 dogs, other than working dogs, over the age of 6 months or
- (b) more than 4 working dogs over the age of 6 months.

Licence for more than 2 dogs over the age of 6 months	\$94.50
Renewal of existing kennel licence (renewal invoices sent annually)	\$44.50

* As defined in the Dog Control Act 2000 on the provision of evidence

Hunting Dogs - must be a current financial member of an approved recognised association (evidence must be provided).

Discounted fee is for one dog only, on the production of a current Pension Card. **N.B. additional dogs full fee applicable.**



LIFE TIME TAGS

These tags are a small metal disc with your dog's unique tag number and Council's contact number on one side, with the other side blank for you to engrave your contact details if you choose. You will still need to register your dog each year and you will continue to receive an annual registration renewal notice.

This tag and its number will stay with your dog for life.
