<p style="text-align: center;">Registering your Animal for the First Time</p> <p>You must provide proof of sterilisation, microchip, pension card details and all documents relevant to receive a fee reduction at the time of registration. It is compulsory for all animals being registered for the first time to be microchipped</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Transfer of Registration</p> <p>Proof of current registration with another Tasmanian Council, and in the same owner's name, must be provided to be eligible for registration tag cost only for the current financial year.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Working Dogs</p> <p>Working dog means a dog used principally for –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) droving or tending livestock; or (b) detecting illegal substances; or (c) searching, tracking or rescuing; or (d) working with police officers. <p>To be eligible, proof or a working dog declaration will need to be provided.</p> <p>Working dogs are exempt from microchipping.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Hunting Dogs and Microchips</p> <p>The only exemption for microchipping a hunting dog is when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> the hunting dog is a member of the: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Northwest Hound Owners Association OR • Tasmanian Field and Game Association <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>the hunting dog has been tattooed by one of the organisations above</p> <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <p>the hunting dog:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • is less than 12 months old or • was born before 1 February 2013 <p>All other hunting dogs must be microchipped.</p>

All dogs aged six months or over MUST BE REGISTERED at all times.

<p style="text-align: center;">Kennel Licence</p> <p>You are required to apply for a Kennel Licence if you intend to keep:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • More than two dogs over the age of six months; or • More than four working dogs over the age of six months 	<p style="text-align: center;">Keep Details Up to Date</p> <p>Please ensure that you keep your animal registration contact details up to date with Council and the relevant microchip organization.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Lifetime Registration Tags</p> <p>The registration tag must be worn when your dog is away from its registered address. The registration tag is a lifetime tag; new tags will not be issued annually.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Animal Pound Information</p> <p>Animals must be registered prior to being released. Fines may be issued for unregistered animals and animals at large. Pound release fees apply. The Council Animal Pound is located at Dogs Home of Tasmania – Devonport – 13 Racecourse Road, Devonport. Opening times are Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday 10:30am to 4:00pm. Monday & Thursday 10:30am to 2:00pm. Weekends 10:30am-12:30pm and 1:30pm -4:00pm. Check times for Public Holidays.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Control of Dogs</p> <p>In accordance with the Dog Control Act 2000, the owner of a dog must keep their dog under effective control by means of a chain, cord or leash held by the owner and attached to the dog while the dog is in a reserve or public place.</p>
