Discounted fee is for one dog only, on the production of a Pension Card
N.B. additional dogs – full fee applicable.

A Kennel Licence is required if you have on your premises, for any period of time:
(a) more than 2 dogs, other than working dogs, over the age of 6 months; or
(b) more than 4 working dogs over the age of 6 months.

Licence for more than 2 dogs over the age of 6 months \$81.50

Renewal of existing kennel licence (renewal invoices sent annually) \$38.50

LIFE TIME TAGS

From 1 July 2019 Kentish Council began issuing "life time" tags for your dog's registration. These new tags are a small metal disc with your dog's unique tag number and Council's contact number on one side, with the other side blank for you to engrave your contact details if you choose. All you need to do is pay the relevant dog registration fee, and your dog's new tag will be issued to you. This tag will stay with your dog for life then you will only be required to pay the renewal fee each year.

All dogs over the age of six months that are not registered will be in breach of the Tasmanian State Government's *Dog Control Act 2000*. Failure to comply will result in a \$172 fine. Property checks may be conducted during the year.
